



Announcing the Technical Publications King Air Maintenance/Parts App for iPad Users! An enhancement to the current Technical Publications iPad app now includes the King Air Interactive Maintenance Library (IML) manuals in PDF format. The app can be used in conjunction with or separate from the current IML manuals on WebView and DVD. The addition of the iPad manuals provides the best of both worlds – full interactivity with WebView and page turner/print friendly capabilities on the iPad. The IML libraries reside within the same app as the Beechcraft and Hawker flight manuals. Users can sync their manuals and download any updates when internet connectivity is



available then access the documentation at any time. Best of all, subscribers to the IML receive access to the iPad app at **no additional charge** and use their existing Beechcraft.com User ID and password.

Functions of the Technical Publications application are:

- Ability to download and manage technical document libraries associated with a specific model of aircraft;
- Receive notifications within the app when updates are available for specific technical documents;
- Add user bookmarks and annotations;
- Bookmarked table of contents for quick navigation of documents;
- View how much memory documents are taking up on the device;
- Print specific pages of the documents with an air printer installed;
- Help documentation available within the app.

The IML app further enhances the Global Customer Support (GCS) network by providing world-class customer service and support at the customer's fingertips. Airliner and Piston IML libraries will be released after the King Air series followed by the Jet libraries. The IML Technical Publications free application can be downloaded through the Apple Store or iTunes.
