Reference: Intel 486 Processor chip “End of Life Notification”

Dear Supplier,

We have been informed by corporate that the Intel 486 Processor chip (p/n UG80486DX4WB100) has been issued an “End of Life Notification” and will be discontinued in March of 2007. Because we have so many pieces of equipment that could possibly be using this processor, RAC needs to know if the Intel 486 is being used in any of our systems.

Please review your products to see if this processor is used in any application and respond back immediately. We need to know:

- 1) Whether or not the Intel 486 processors are in any products you sell to RAC
- 2) If so, what P/N's are affected and approximately how many chips per part
- 3) What stock you have which will be applied to RAC parts

Again, this request is urgent in nature so please respond by C.O.B today, December 13, 2006.

Please send a R.O.M. estimate, if needed, in parallel to a more precise counting.
